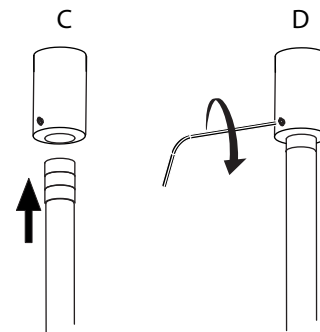
After having marked anchor location on the ceiling, screw in ceiling anchors using appropriate screws

Loosen set screw and lower ceiling rod to allow mount to be screwed into the ceiling anchor

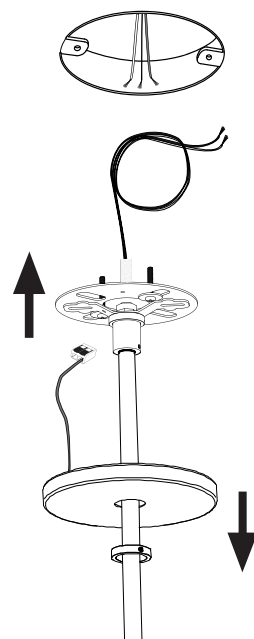
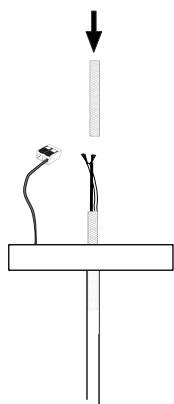


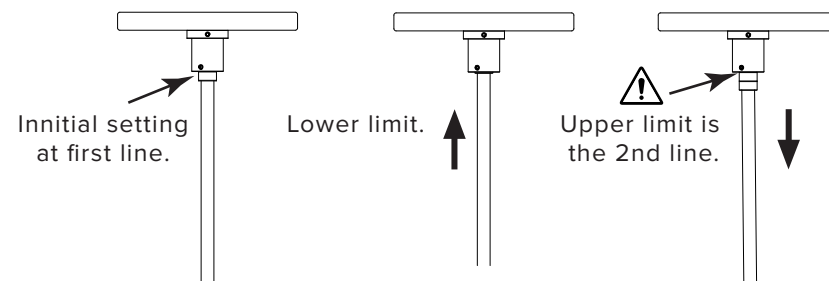
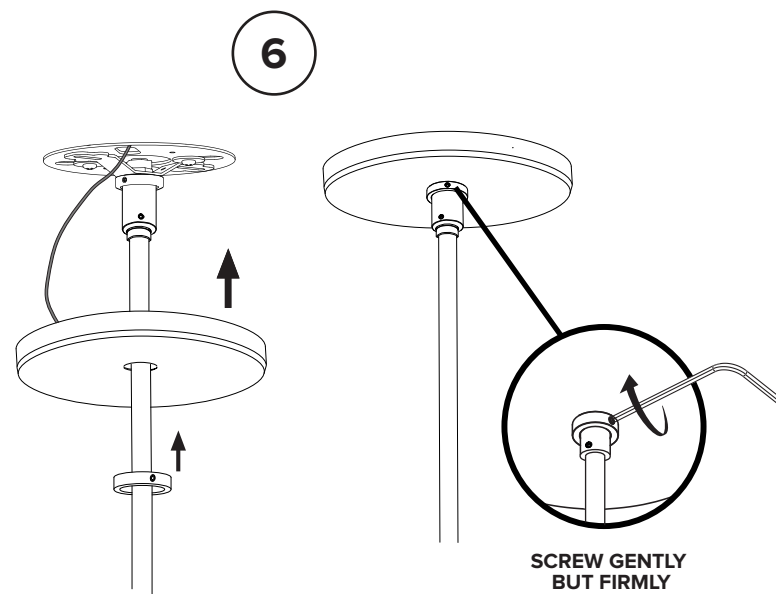
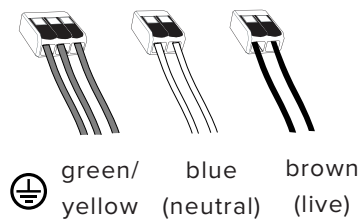
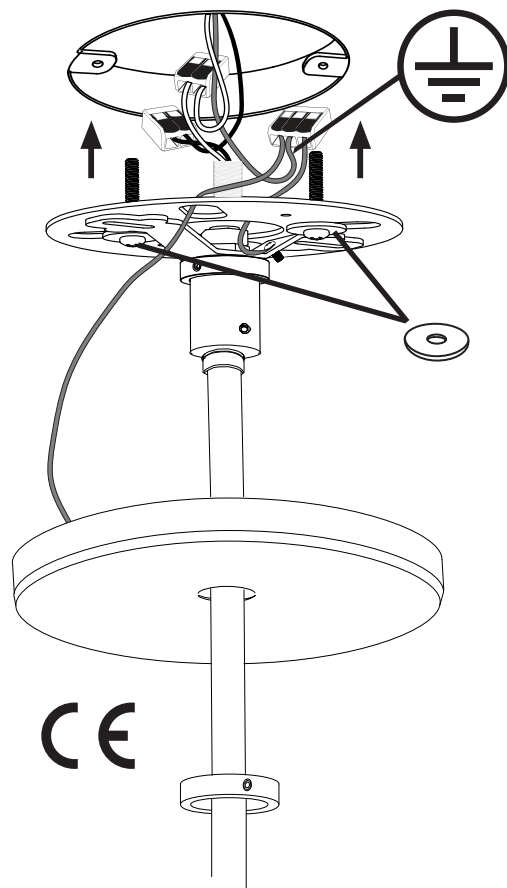
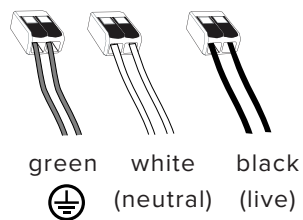
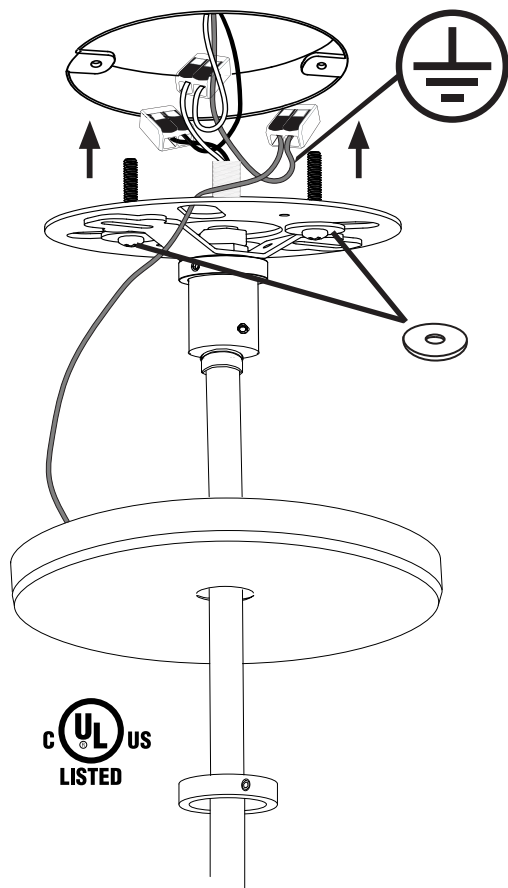

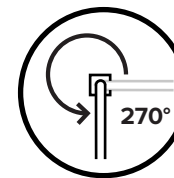
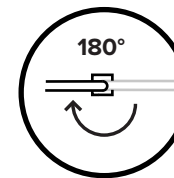
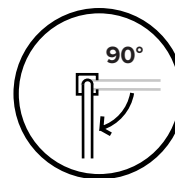
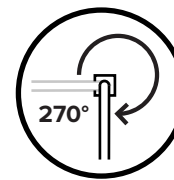
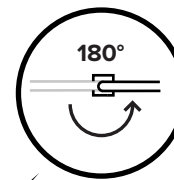
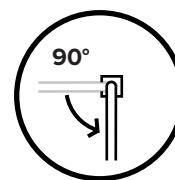
Reposition arms into their proper final positions. These arms were turned to facilitate shipping

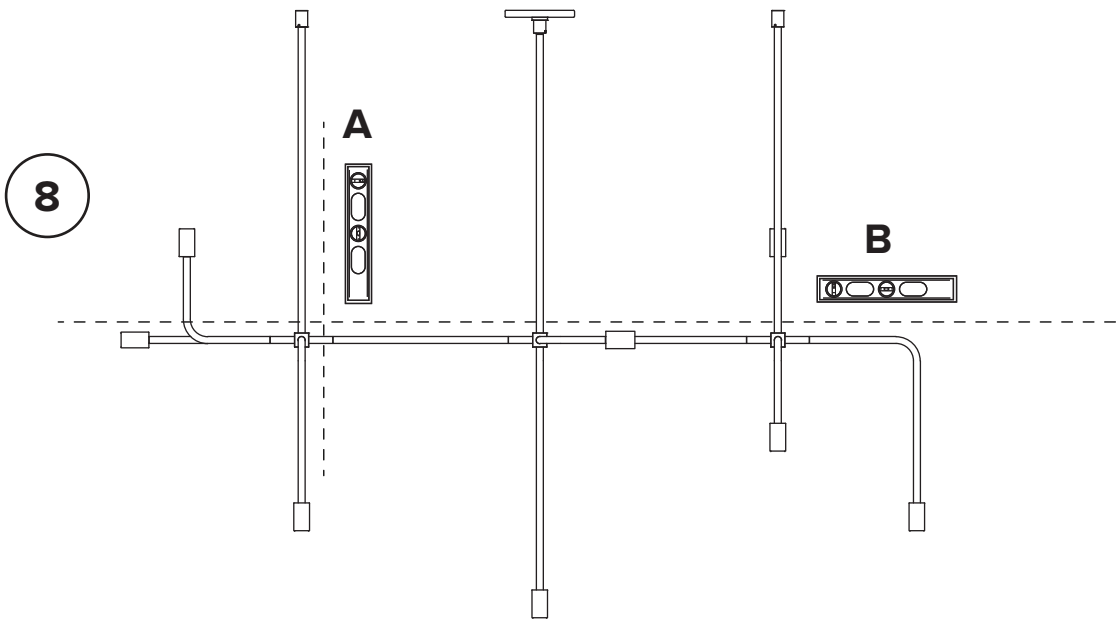


Loosen set screw, reposition arm then tighten set screw gently, but firmly.



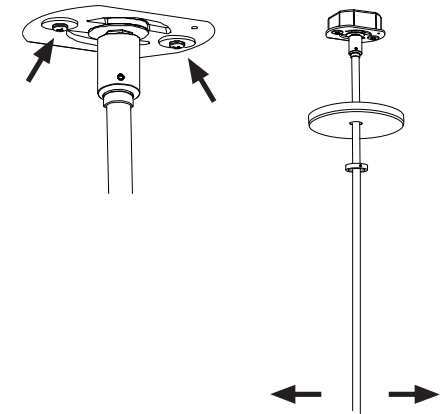
Rotate arms shortest distance possible.  
Do not rotate 3/4 turn.



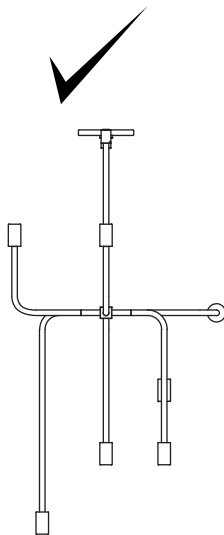

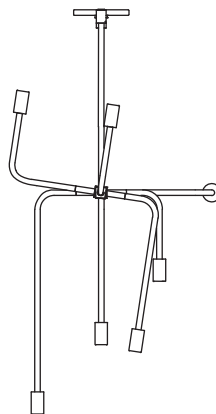
Horizontal level is adjusted by tightening and loosening the ceiling mount screws. Be sure that screws are sufficiently secured for safety



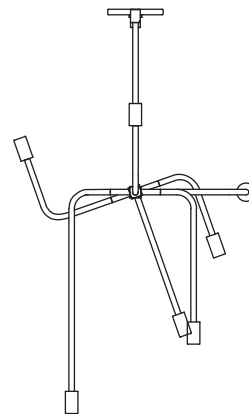
Cubes may have shifted during shipping so assure that all cubes are straight and parallel with one another

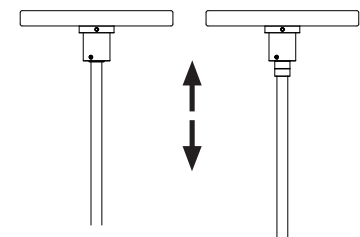
