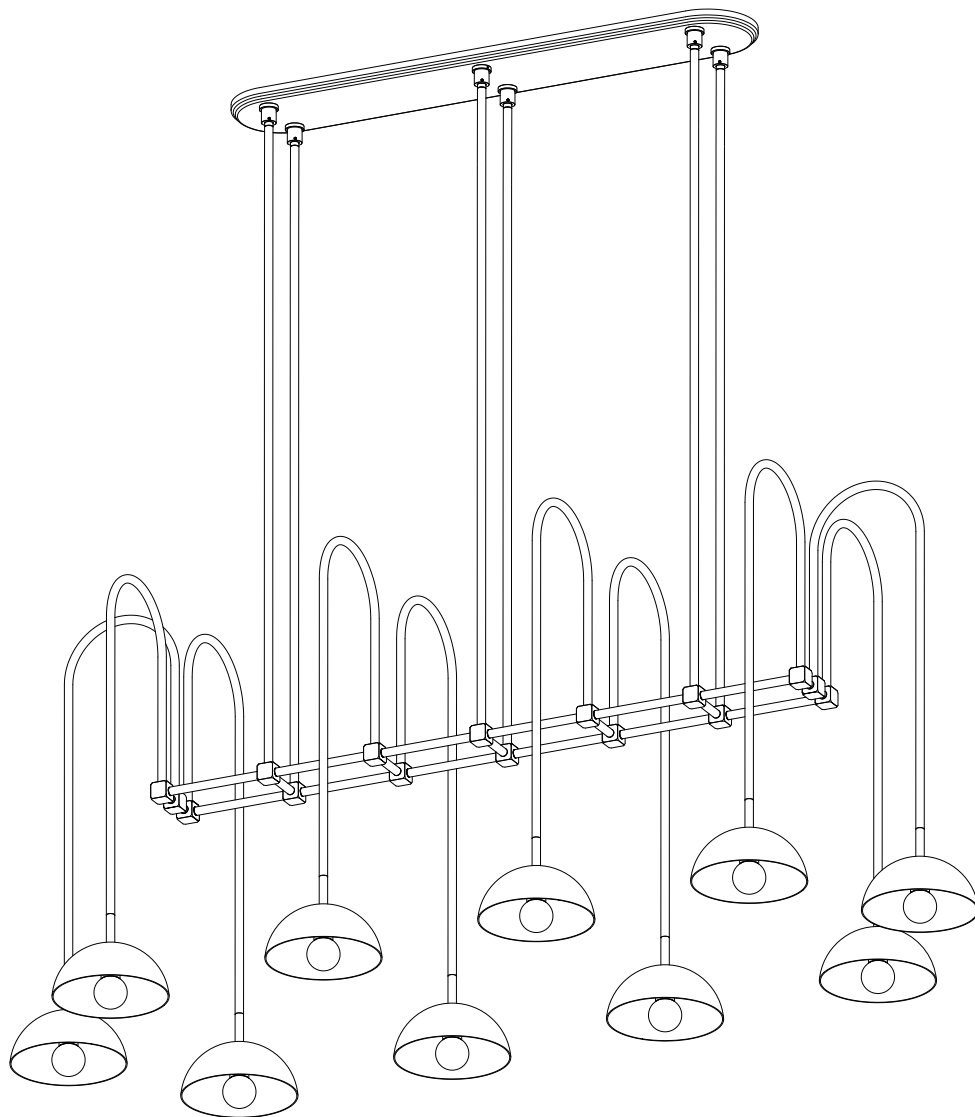


## BEAUBIEN 56

- Handle materials with care. Please consult lamp maintenance sheet on our web site



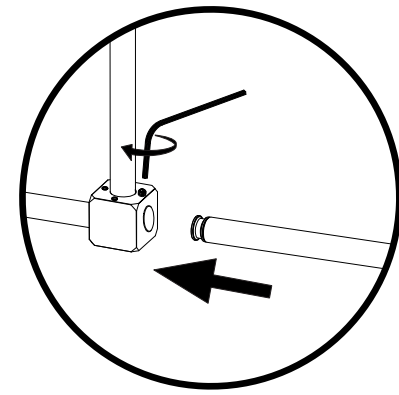
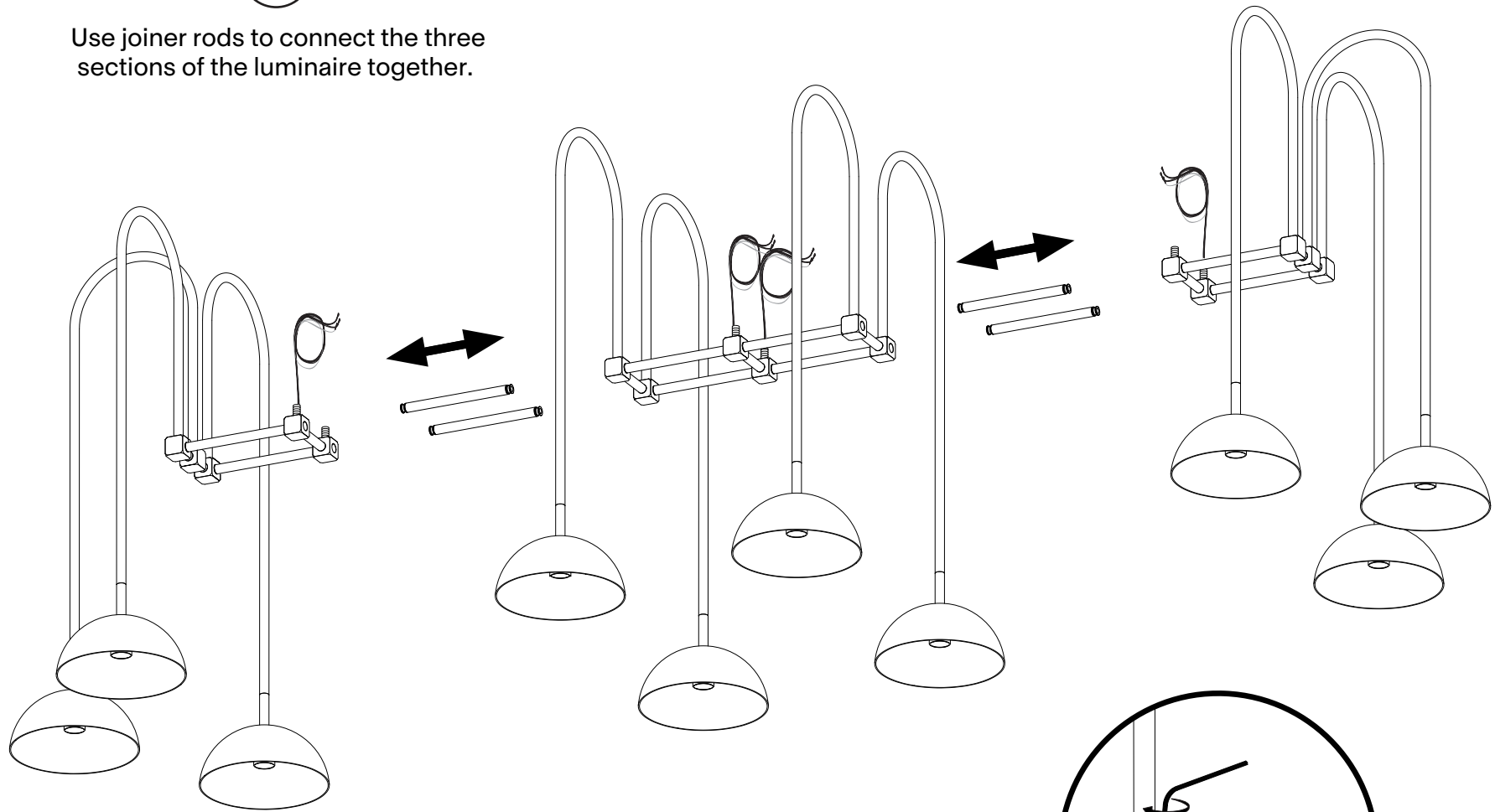

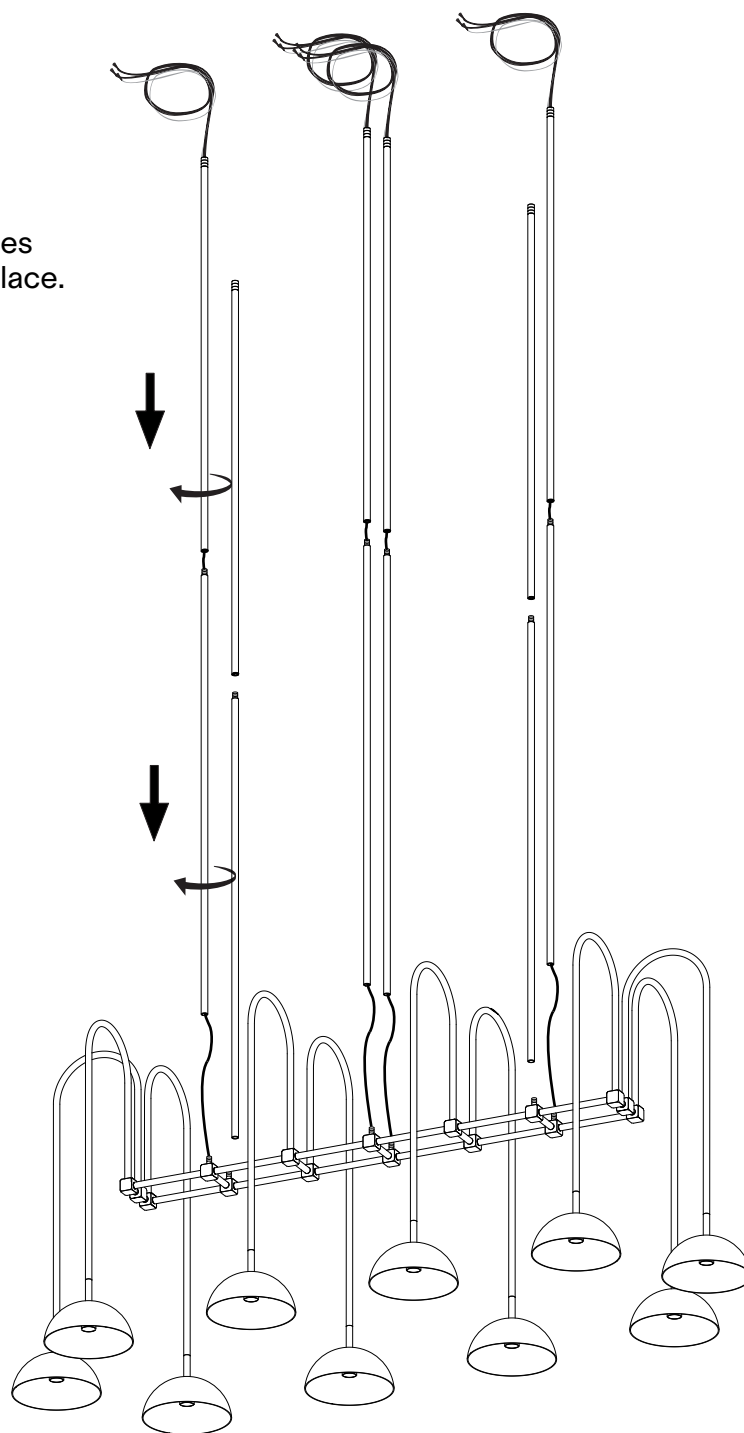
Use joiner rods to connect the three sections of the luminaire together.



Insert joining rods, then tighten set screw gently, but firmly.

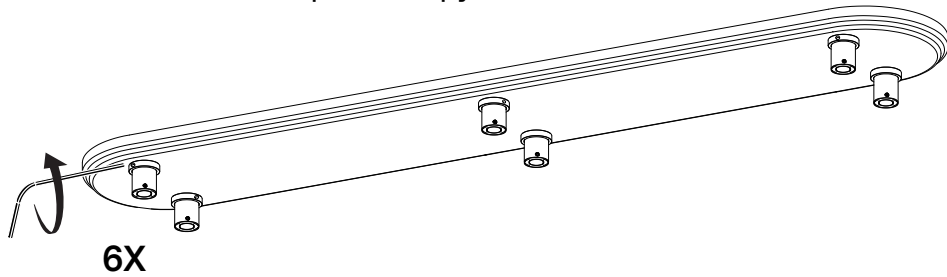

and rotate both segments into place.



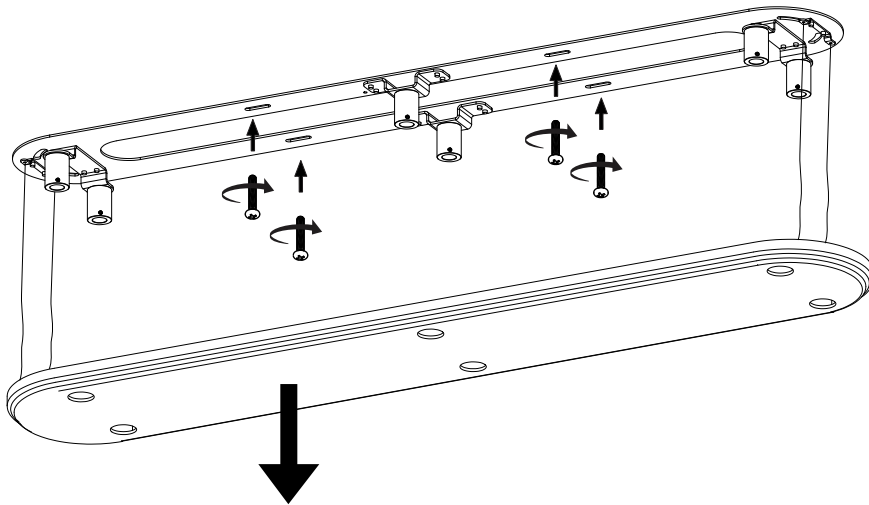

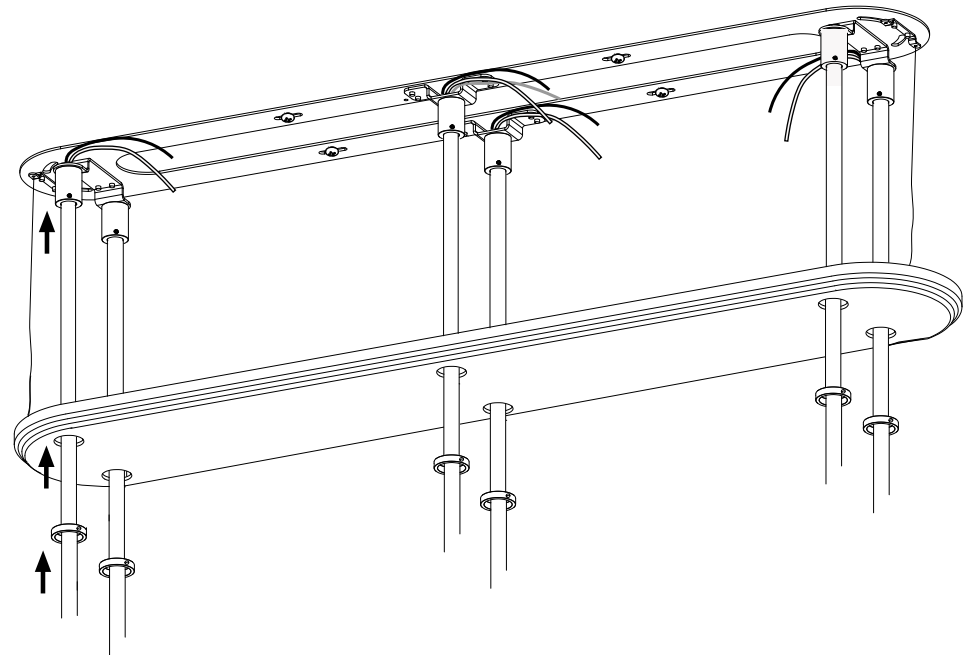
The cover is held in place with four steel cables. Mount bracket to ceiling using appropriate anchors.

Pass the tiges through slip ring, canopy cover, then into the anchor following steps A to C.

Micro-adjustments can be made later.



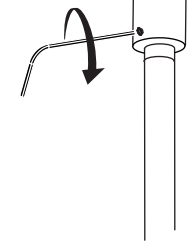

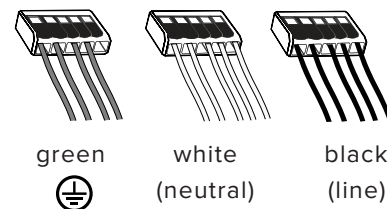

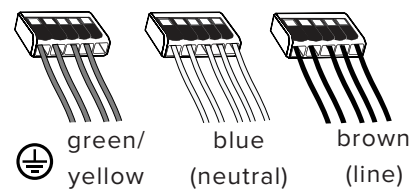

for 120 V wiring

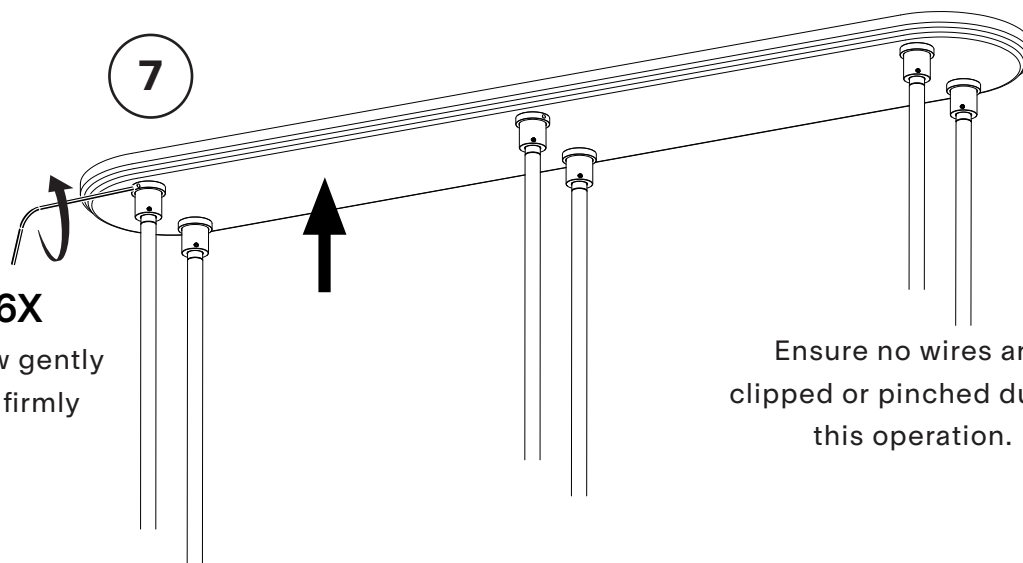


for 220-240 V wiring



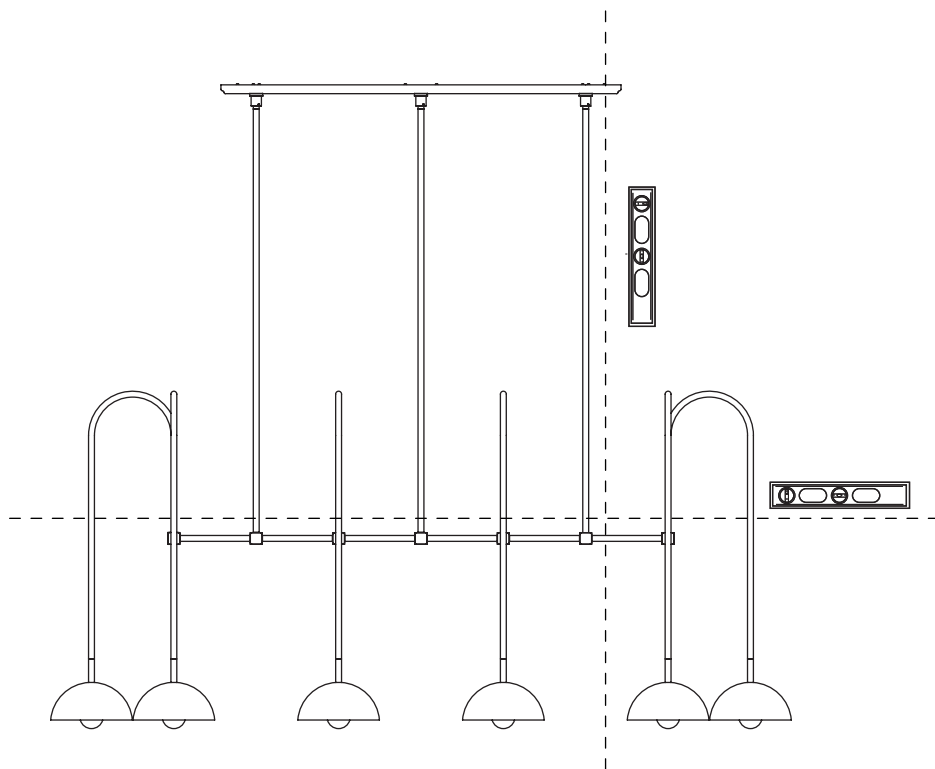

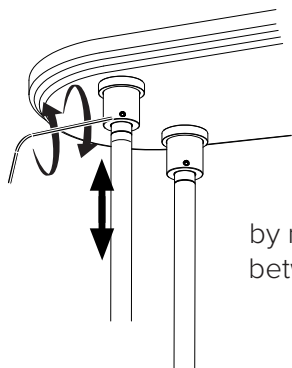
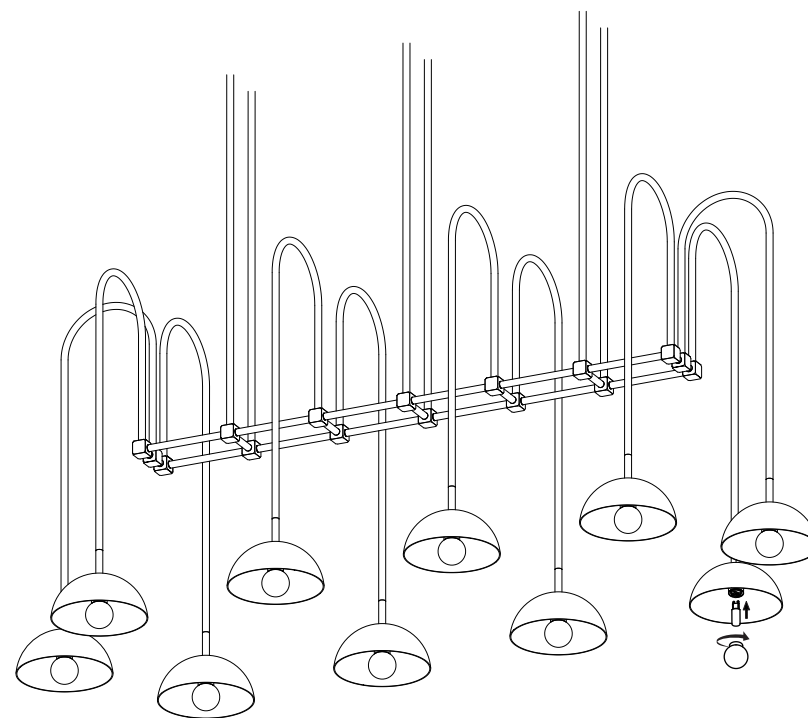


Ensure no wires are
